Among the colleges in urban and rural areas of our Washim district, Salunka Bai Raut College, Vanoja, has the only N. C. C. Unit, established by 11 Maharashtra Battalion NCC, Akola. Accordingly, the aspiring students admitted to the college are getting attention for their country service as per their qualifications to be recruited as Agniveer in all three branches of the military, namely Army, Navy, Air Force. Apart from this, our students are also being selected in the government security department and private security department due to their NCC education.

Detailed information about various programs conducted under the NCC department in the academic session 2023 - 24 is as follows.

1) National Yoga Day 21 June 2023

Students admitted to the college in 11th to 12th and graduation are eligible to join NCC, but the admission selection process is carried out for those who want to join. Under the admission process, the height, weight, running, ability to sit exams, written test, and various other criteria are applied to complete the recruitment process and 140 boys and 15 girls newly admitted from the college participated in the recruitment process. Training Officer Subedar Darshan Singh BHM Bhupendra Singh of 11 Maharashtra Battalion was present to conduct




