Our college was the unique college for having NCC Unit in the Washim district. The students, who are physically strong and interested to serve the nation by joining defense services, are admitted in NCC Unit. The institution provides such student an opportunity to join their interested field by providing them training along with quality education.

Among the urban and rural colleges in our Washim district, Salunkabai Raut College is the only one college in the washim district having N. C. C sinnor division unit. The unit has been working under 11 Maharashtra Battalion NCC, Akola. In this connection, the college aspiring students are getting attention for their meritorious service in the Army.

Recruitment of new cadets for NCC in this session in our college was processed on Thursday 09/10/2021. Two NCC officers, Subhedar Major Ashok Kumar Sir and Havaldar Vinod Kumar had been sent by 11 Maharashtra Battalion NCC Akola for the new enrollment. Out of the 225 students to be recruited from Washim district, 26 students were selected rigorously as per the rules of the battalion. Students in the selection process were selected after checking height, weight, and body fitness, running, push ups, and other tests. The epidemic corona rule was also enforced on the day of this recruitment process.

During this session, tree planting work was done by the NCC unit of the college, cleaning of the premises and cleaning of Bholenath old age home on 2nd October as well as cleaning of Shri Gajanan Maharaj temples in the area. Helped rural farmers by registering E-crops. The unit also carried out plastic eradication activities in the area and in the Satii Aai temple area of Chikhali, Selu Bazaar district Washim. The Katepurna river in Fetra village was cleaned by collecting waste and plastic. Awareness rallies were held in Wanoja and other villages to prevent the Corona epidemic. The college celebrated National Student Army Day on September 23. Campus cleaning campaign was carried out on the occasion of 73rd NCC Day. Also NCC cadet Snake-friend cadet Satish Gawande went to the battalion camp and gave information about the art of catching snakes. In addition the cadets worked on Pulse Polio Awareness, as well as security arrangements during the Corona period.

Ms. Manjusha More Madam, P.S.I., Police Station Shelubazar and Hon'ble PI Ingle Saheb, Police Station Mangrulpir guided the cadets to join variou defense forces. As well as 11 Maharashtra Battalion Lt. Colonel C.P. Bhadola Sir also visited the College on 21/5/2022 for annual administrative inspection and audit of the sub unit and inspected the work and work accounting of the unit.

This year, 26 cadets entered the college NCC sub-unit in the first year, 19 cadets in the second year and 22 cadets in the third year. 
.After that, a rally was taken out from the village. The students created public awareness by raising slogans to stop female feticide. A total of 97 students participated in the rally.

Constitution Day Celebrated


