





On January 25, 2023, three people were seriously injured in a head-on collision between a two-wheeler in Kasmar, during which timely medical assistance was provided to all the injured.

On February 2, 2023, the forest department extinguished a massive fire that broke out in the regional forest at Vanoja.

On March 4, 2023, a special shramsanskar camp held at Rajura Bazar in Warud gave lessons in disaster management to the participants.

On March 10, 2023, a 4-foot-long snake was rescued from an anganwadi in Tapovan.

On March 10, 2023, Nilgai, who fell into a 15-feet deep well in PimpriSurve, was rescued with the help of the forest department.

On March 11, 2023, a helping hand was extended to the injured at the interchange of samruddhi highway.


On March 19, 2023, six injured in the accident at Pedgaon were provided with medical assistance on time.


World Forest Day was celebrated on March 22 at Katepurna Wildlife Sanctuary in association with the college and the sanctuary.

## NCC REPORT

2021-22

Among the urban and rural colleges in our Washim district, Salunkabai Raut College is the only one college in the washim district having N. C. C sinner division unit. The unit has been working under 11 Maharashtra Battalion NCC, Akola. In this connection, the college aspiring students are getting attention for their meritorious service in the Army.

Recruitment of new cadets for NCC in this session in our college was processed on Thursday 09/10/2021. Two NCC officers, Subhedar Major Ashok Kumar Sir and Havaladar Vinod Kumar had been sent by 11 Maharashtra Battalion NCC Akola for the new enrollment. Out of the 225 students to be recruited from Washim district, 26 students were selected rigorously as per the rules of the battalion. Students in the selection process were selected after checking height, weight, and body fitness, running, push ups, and other tests. The epidemic corona rule was also enforced on the day of this recruitment process.

During this session, **tree planting** work was done by the NCC unit of the college, cleaning of the premises and cleaning of Bholenath old age home on 2nd October as well as cleaning of Shri Gajanan Maharaj temples in the area. Helped rural farmers by registering E-crops. The unit also carried out **plastic eradication** activities in the area and in the Satii Aai temple area of Chikhali, Selu Bazaar district Washim. The Katepurna river in Fetra village was cleaned by collecting waste and plastic. Awareness rallies were held in Wanoja and other villages to prevent the Corona epidemic.
